Grades Nine-Twelve

- **All Accounting classes:** basic calculator or better, notebook, pencils and eraser
- **Geometry & Algebra 1 & 2** – scientific calculator, 1 ½ inch binder w/ dividers/ notebook or loose leaf paper, different color pens, pencils
- **Pre-Calc** – graphing calculator is recommended (TI-84 series)
- **Stats** – 1 ½ inch binder w/ dividers; notebook or loose leaf paper; different color pens, pencils, graphing calculator is recommended (TI-84 series)
- **General Science & Chemistry:** 1 inch binder, folder, Scientific Calculator (TI-30Xa or higher), Looseleaf paper or notebook, colored pencils, pencils and pens, 1 pack of red pens **For Chemistry:** splash-proof googles
- **Biology:** composition notebook, highlighters, colored pencils, notebook
- **AP Biology:** same items as Biology plus 1 ½ inch or 2 inch binder w/ 8-10 dividers
- **All Music classes:** pencils and 2 boxes of Kleenex
- **Spanish 1:** 3 subject notebook, green pen, black dry erase markers
- **Spanish 2-3:** dry erase markers
- **Spanish 4 & 5:** quality English-Spanish/Spanish-English dictionary
- **Spanish 5:** journal notebook
